Initial Referee Rating***

*** A new referee will be assigned as a 500 unless there is additional information available to support a higher evaluation. The above criteria will be used as the starting point for making the initial evaluation.

Referee Assessment Process

- Assessments are driven by:
 - FCSOA President and/or Board requests
 - FCSOA Ranking Committee requests
 - Individual referee desiring ranking upgrade
 - Multiple negative feedback from schools
- Obtain current FCSOA referee rating by
 - Contacting Ranking Committee Chairman or
 - Contacting FCSOA President
 - Referee ratings are confidential data

Referee Assessment Process (Continued)

- Referee assessments shall be processed through the Assessment Chairman.
- Referee assessments shall be in accordance with SCSOA guidelines
- For individual referee assessments, contact Assessment Chairman.
- Assessment Chairman coordinates with Assignor for game level and details.

Referee Assessment Requests (Continued)

- Assessment Chairman notifies referee assessment date.
- Referee shall submit \$40.00 assessment fee. Check endorsed to FCSSOA c/o Treasurer
- Assessor provides verbal assessment to referee after game match.
- Formal written assessment report is mailed to referee within 7 days. Copies to President and Ranking Committee Chairman.

Referee Assessment Requests (Continued)

- Assessor will complete FCSSOA Evaluation Feed Back and SCSSOA Referee Assessment Forms
- Assessment Chairman will compile referee field evaluations and prepare final assessment report.
- Assessor will mail final evaluation / assessment forms to evaluated /assessed official and provide copies to FCSSOA President and Ranking Committee Chairman.
