Referee Assessment Process

- A. Get your current FCSOA referee rating
 - 1. Referee rankings are annually reviewed & revised per latest Board concensus.
 - 2. Contact Ranking Committee Chairman or
 - 3. Contact FCSOA President
 - 4. Contact Assessment Chairman and request a formal assessment

Referee Assessment Process

5. Assessment Chairman coordinates with Assignor for game level and details.
6. Individual Assessment Requests & Upgrades require a \$50.00 assessment fee. Endorse check to FCSOA and mail to:

Referee Assessment Process

7. SCSOA guidelines are followed for FCSSOA assessments.
8. Assessment Chairman notifies referee with Assessor name, assessment date, game level, game time and venue.
9. Assessor provides verbal assessment to referee after game match.

Referee Assessment Process

10. Assessor will compile referee field evaluations and prepare final assessment report.

11. Assessor will mail a Formal Written Assessment Report within 7 days of assessment. Copies to:
 - Assessed Referee
 - Assessment Chairman
 - Fcsoa President
 - Ranking Committee Chairman.
