

Foothill Citrus Soccer Officials Association
Playoffs/Finals Selection Procedure

- 1) Pre-requisites for being selected:
- 2)
 - a) Must have been a member for at least 2 years.
 - b) Must have minimum 2 years experience as Referee or Assistant Referee on Diagonal System of Control..
 - c) Member in good standing. (No outstanding disciplinary issues)
 - d) Rating of Unit equivalent to “1or 100” required to do center referee position.
 - e) Rating of Unit equivalent to “1or 100”, or “2 or 200” required to do assistant referee position.
 - f) Must be able to pass National Intercollegiate Soccer Officials Association physical.
 - g) Must be able to pass a FCSOA High School Rules test at the 90 percentile.
 - h) Passing or failing any of the above criteria is to be determined by the FCSOA Instructional, Assessment, and Rating committee members.
 - i) A Coach or School Administrator (Southern Section or LA City) may not do any **Playoff game or Final** (By CIF adoption)
- 3) During December, the Unit teams must be assessed by (2) SCSOA assessors on the same game or (1) SCSOA and (1) Unit assessor assigned by SCSOA Chairman. All results must be turned into SCSOA Chairman of Assessments by January 2nd.
- 4) During January, on a Saturday, SCSOA will convene a clinic for all candidates participating in the Finals. **THIS IS A MANDATORY CLINIC, NO EXCEPTIONS! FAILURE TO ATTEND ELIMINATES ANY MEMBER OF A FINALS CREW FROM PARTICIPATION.**
- 5) Requirements of Candidates to participate or be selected to do one of the Finals.
 - A) Referees cannot do finals if they work games for 2 chapters.
 - B) Officials must have been assessed by SCSOA.
 - C) No Finals team or team member will participate in any **QUARTER OR SEMIFINAL GAME!**
 - D) Must be available on Friday and Saturday, Days of Southern Section and Los Angeles City Finals (time to be determined after Semi Finals)
 - E) Must have appropriate Long Sleeve Jersey (Gold pin stripe), (Red, Blue & Black Pin stripe USSF Colors).
 - F) No Referee can do two successive years in a row as Center Referee.
 - G) Center referees may come back as assistant referees, and assistant referees meeting center referee criteria may come back as Center referees
